Forget what you know about illusionists: no cheesy tuxedos, no rabbits to pull out of hats. Brock Gill leads a new generation of edgy, daring illusionists, amazing audiences with his unique stage show, dry wit, and mind-blowing escapes. While working at a saw mill in 1997, Brock felt that God wanted him to use illusions, escapes, and stunts to bring a message of hope to people. "It didn't make any sense," Brock admits, "but I felt like it was what God was calling me to do." With a passion for reaching people as the catalyst, Brock went back to college and began performing at church outreach events.

News of his creative method of evangelism spread through the area quickly and he began to receive invitations almost immediately.

Since those first outreaches, God has taken Brock's ministry across the United States and into Mexico and Australia, and his heart for the lost has grown.

Brock's message for Christ is clear and effective. He has literally seen thousands of lives touched by God through his ministry.
